
The 2024 edition will be an extremely tough act to follow. Its site, Les Grandes Locos, brought a fresh dimension to the festival: bigger, more vibrant. Lastly, the festival will write a new chapter in its shared history with the local area, occupying the urban playground that surrounds it with a series of free daytime events (to be announced at a later date). These original contemporary formats serve to provide festival-goers with yet more opportunities to ride our festive wave.

Recapturing this energy is a mouthwatering prospect, something joyful and euphoric on the horizon, like an antidote. Let us celebrate!



VISUAL IDENTITY

DIA, A DUO WITH CHARACTER(S)

Meg and Mitch live between New York and Chamonix, and share a passion for art. Together, they have created DIA - Dreamers Ink Aesthetics in long form - a studio where letters and shapes come to life to create an immersive, never-before-seen visual experience.

At DIA, nothing is static: everything is circulation, cadence and vibration. Typography leaves its comfort zone: it moves, lives and metamorphoses, animated, stretched or textured.


This characteristic use of motion design and generative tools has built the reputation of the New York studio. Large and small alike have called on their deft sense of rhythm: Apple, Balenciaga, Nike, Saint Laurentor the Biennale de Chaumont to name but a few. But DIA doesn't limit itself to commissions. As teachers and researchers, they like to explore and push the boundaries of graphic design.

A MINIMALIST AND A DYNAMIC APPROACH

The 2025 poster stands out for its bold approach to black and white.

We had already explored this approach for the 5th edition in 2007.

For Nuits sonores, DIA created a customized generative particle system, capturing the immersive, rhythmic energy of sound waves. The aim was to translate the visceral pulse of live music - the tangible impact felt in concerts and clubs - into a dynamic visual experience.





FESTIVAL VENUES



LES GRANDES LOCOS

After an initial exploration in 2024, Nuits sonores is once again bringing its Days and Closing Day to Les Grandes Locos, the former SNCF technical center located in La Mulatière. This site, with its towering halls and mechanical remnants, hosts 4 stages offering different experiences, becoming a living space for five days.



LA SUCRIÈRE

Nuits sonores is rethinking the format of its Nuits program for its 2025 edition, offering an enhanced experience in La Sucrière's upgraded version. Behind this initiative is the desire to recreate a large, unique site for Nuits sonores, with three stages designed as spaces for distinctive experiences: a 360° dancefloor, an intimate club, and an immersive live space, Le Sucre. These spaces are dedicated to strong artistic communities, offering a panorama of both international and local scenes.



HEAT

HEAT is a place for sharing and encounters, bringing together a community of restaurateurs and offering a cultural program throughout the year. During Nuits sonores, the dining hall hosts a series of open-air events.



HÔTEL71/H7

The Arty Farty association's team hub, Hôtel71 is a place for the transmission and support of cultural and media projects, located in the heart of the Confluence district. The building hosts part of the Nuits sonores Lab program during the festival, as does its neighbor H7, a hub for digital innovation.



LES CÉLESTINS

In 2010, Nuits sonores took over the Place des Célestins with a memorable Apéro sonore and invited The Residents for an extraordinary stage performance. In 2025, Nuits sonores is once again opening the doors of the theater, settling into the magnificent setting of this symbolic venue in the City of Lyon, designed by architect Gaspard André, for a Special Concert, orchestrated by composer Suzanne Ciani. More than 200 years of architectural and dramatic arts history meet decades of electronic music history.



LE THÉÂTRE DE LA CROIX-ROUSSE

In the heart of the Canuts district, the Théâtre de la Croix-Rousse offers an inclusive and engaged theater, attentive to new narratives and forms. It is committed to forging strong ties with its community, involving artists, citizens, and cultural partners. A vibrant space, mindful of social and environmental issues, where contemporary creation is written and shared.



ESPACE PUBLIC ET LIEUX CULTURELS LYONNAIS

Returning to the city and urban space, the historical playground of Nuits sonores: public squares and cultural venues in Lyon are this year key stops in the festival for anyone looking to (re)discover the city to the rhythm of the events and the Extra! program.

All the main sites of Nuits Sonores are accessible to people with disabilities.

DAYS · **EDITO**

To reflect changes in our society, to explore interactions between cultures and territories, from modern styles to artistic roots, from the legendary figures of our movements to up-and-coming artists: this is both the concept and the pledge of the Days programme at Nuits Sonores.

Artists possessing an intimate and longstanding relationship with the festival and its audiences – who have offered, over the years, a series of constantly evolving collaborations, shows and creative visions – will be joined by those discovering this unique festival, and the singular atmosphere of Les Grandes Locos, for the very first time.

The Days programme is a pluralist vision made up of multiple contrasting aesthetics, ranging from the raw and extreme sounds of hardcore and industrial to more contemplative, organic and minimalist styles. Its lineup highlights these contrasts, while confidently building bridges between genres.

As a constant source of creativity, inventiveness and imagination, diversity is indispensable to culture. At our daytime site, this diversity will be showcased across four stages offering myriad experiences: the vast and imposing Nef stage; a stage resembling an intimate garage, dedicated to experimentation; a visually stunning outdoor stage surrounded by scaffolding; and lastly, a Soundsystem area where the speakers are as important as the artists as an element of both the dancefloor and the visual setting.

The spirit of this programme is perfectly represented by the contrasting stylings of Nadah El Shazly, a vocalist and producer from Cairo, who blends expressive 19th century musical concepts from her native country with improvisation and unrestricted contemporary forays into electronic idioms. Another striking example of this artistic depth comes in the form of Lyra Pramuk, whose organic, powerful, lyrical voice is juxtaposed with synthetic, distorted, dramatic compositions. The attitude of Avalanche Kaito, oscillating between punk and noise while drawing on the traditional griot sounds of Burkina Faso, also embodies this duality. These are contrasts that, paradoxically, merge to become one and serve to fuel creation. Or, in the words of Nubyan Twist: "Music is the ultimate narrative for unity". The group, whose

music fuses broken beat, hip-hop, soul and jazz, is another clear example of an act that holds the fusion of genres dear to its heart. Renick Bell, a live coding pioneer and leading figure in algorave, will immerse us in his algorithmic meanderings on the 12-metre giant screen at La Nef des Grandes Locos. The inventor of his own coding system, this professor from the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology (RMIT) defies the boundaries of digital technology and sound. Raïna Raï, considered to be one of the founding fathers of modern raï (more commonly known as "electric raï") fuses and accentuates the contrast between traditional rhythms and instruments and saturated rock sounds. Lastly, artists such as Legit Girl, Follakzoïd and Minna-No-Kimochi do away with genre boundaries altogether, offering a musical experience without limits.

Such contrasts will also be showcased in a series of rare, at times unprecedented, encounters between artists such as Airod and DJ Physical, Flore and Special Request, Mall Grab and Dylan Dylan, Surusinghe and TSVI, Ellen Allien and BADSISTA, Helena Hauff and DJ Mell G, Âme and Curses, and Forest Drive West and Azu Tiwaline. Not to mention in the mouthwatering b2b2b set featuring three generations of iconic French artists: Cassius, Myd and Bambounou.

In keeping with the festival's traditions, part of the programme will also be reserved for acts with a political and social conscience, including some of the techno scene's most militant figures. In 1990, a few years after the birth of techno in Detroit, Mike Banks and Jeff Mills - the latter of whom will be closing the festival this year - founded the Underground Resistance collective and label. They would soon be joined by Robert Hood, who will also appear on the Outdoor stage. Their music forms part of a wider political struggle against racism, police violence and social inequality, and their productions have become a rallying point for counter-cultural resistance around the world. Feminist resistance will also be on show at Nuits Sonores, with artists including Neoperreo. After dancing to the rhythms of SassyGirl and Tomasa Del Real, this year's festival-goers can also discover Rosa Pistola, who is breaking down and rewriting the macho codes of reggaeton. Lyon's politically

engaged scene will also take centre stage in the form of DJ Chuimix, a militant figure on the local techno scene, and his label Criminal Justice Act, a reference to the dark days when electronic music was outlawed in the UK. Lastly, the outdoor stage will welcome Honey Dijon, an iconic American artist who is campaigning for "control of the narrative", a reappraisal of the narratives behind electronic music that will bring greater recognition and visibility to the role played by black and LGBTQIA+communities in birthing house and techno.

Independent music and alternative scenes are also battlegrounds in the struggles against colonialism and the erasure of peoples. In Ukraine and Georgia, there is a shared desire in cultural spaces for emancipation from Russian imperialism. In Palestine, the cultural scene serves as one of the fronts of resistance against ethnic cleansing and as a means to assert the existence and identity of a people. Through clubs, radio stations and artists, the cultural sectors in these countries offer a space for their communities to come together and take action. By extending invitations to the online radio stations Mutant and AlHara, the Palestinian artist Julmud and the Ukrainian artist Gael, Nuits Sonores embodies the Georgian slogan: "We Dance Together, We Fight Together".

The line-up also includes historic names such as Luke Vibert, an acid legend signed to Aphex Twin's Rephlex records, and Juno Reactor, the group that created the soundtracks to The Matrix and the Mortal Kombat videogames, widely considered to be the very first Goa trance act.

Last but not least, the Days programme will showcase the local region and its thriving artistic scene. The festival will open with Khalil Epi's live A/V set Aïchoucha, a veritable cinematic epic and an immersion in the traditional heritage of Tunisian music. Also to be found performing on the Days stages will be: compulsive digger CallBackSami; Syrob, the resident DJ and legendary programmer of the 101 club in Clermont-Ferrand: Karissa and Mimi Géniale of the Club Cardio collective: the contemplative live show by Salma Rosa and Jonnnah; the indomitable Wayatt, founder of the Emo Crystal Cult nights; master percussion duo Belzebuth GX (Jacques Satre and Eiger Drums Propaganda); Saku Sahara, a purveyor of sharp Amen breaks: Vel, a resident at Le Sucre and the new face on Anetha's Mama Told Ya label: and Axymt of the Monochrome collective and label. Not forgetting, of course, LB aka Labat, another resident of Le Sucre and a leading figure on the Lyon art scene, who will be presenting his brand new live A/V show.

And where would the Days programme at Nuits Sonores be without the regulars who have already left such an indelible imprint on the festival's history? This year, they include Bicep, Peggy Gou, Anetha and Vitalic – performing Kompromat, his live duet with Rebeka Warrior –, each of whom have delighted audiences time and again throughout the festival's history.

LB aka LABAT LIVE AV

Poumpet, Steel City Dance Discs I Lyon/Paris, France

The local hero LB aka LABAT is back at Nuits sonores to present his brand-new AV live show! First and foremost, a compulsive digger with a passion for collecting jazz, hip-hop, soul, funk, and more, he breaks down this raw material, manipulates it, and rebuilds it with the help of his machines to create a percussive and warm sound. Known for his devilish edits in which he transforms rap tracks into Ghetto Tech anthems, as well as his Acid House-infused productions, he's constantly dropping remixes, collaborations, and making appearances with artists like Partiboi69, KiNK, Sally C. and Mall Grab!

BICEP PRESENT CHROMA AV DI SET

CHROMA, Ninja Tune | London, United Kingdom

It's a beautiful story that continues to unfold between Bicep and Nuits Sonores! After showcasing their first two albums live at the 2018 and 2022 editions, the British duo returns to Lyon to unveil CHROMA: a true sonic and visual show, as per their usual, inspired by their new eponymous label, With CHROMA, Bicep has carved out a space for artistic freedom, allowing them to fully embrace their inspirations, unbound by genre labels. This project explores a broader sound palette, slightly darker and decidedly club-oriented. Since 2017, their breathtaking live performances have become a real phenomenon, renowned for their epic and immersive productions. Among the most admired producers in the world. Bicep continues to solidify their place as one of the most essential electronic acts of our time!

MOXIE b2b WALLACE

On Loop, Tartan Records | United Kingdom

Moxie and Wallace share much more than their roles as curators and label founders — respectively, On Loop and Tartan Records. These key figures in the UK electronic scene share a common love for house, deep house, techno, and dubby, groovy, percussive sounds. A staple in the dance music world, Moxie is an iconic voice and a resident DJ on NTS Radio for over 12 years, while also performing at clubs and festivals worldwide. Wallace, on the other hand, is emerging as a producer to watch closely, with notable releases on Mule Musiq, Studio Barnhus, Rhythm Section, CWPT, and Disco Halal!

KHALIL EPI PRÉSENTE AÏCHOUCHA LIVE AV

Shouka | Lyon, France

Composer, multi-instrumentalist, and videographer, Khalil Epi is the unmissable figure in the electronic and contemporary reinterpretation of traditional and popular Tunisian music. Moving between electro-pop, jazz, club, and classical music, he has been collaborating for years with artists, dancers, and musicians, while also managing the Franco-Tunisian label Shouka. Based in Lyon, he will present Aichoucha at Nuits sonores 2025, an immersive audiovisual experience that fuses his music with videos captured across Tunisia!

MINNA-NO-KIMOCHI

Mizuha | Tokyo, Japan

Minna-no-kimochi (みんなのきもち) is the pioneering collective leading a true Post-Trance renaissance in Tokyo. Alongside their label Mizuha (罔象), they've crafted a unique style by deconstructing 90s trance and 2010s EDM with a distinctly post-club interpretation. As the vanguard of this new generation of Trance, the group organizes raves in abandoned buildings around Tokyo. Their standout performances in clubs, as well as on NTS and Boiler Room, have resonated on the international stage!



DJ PHYSICAL b2b AIROD

Young Savage | Paris, France

2025 will mark the first collaboration between Airod and DJ Physical. Known for his unique touch, Airod creates a perfect balance between old-school inspirations and modern production techniques, with a sharp sense of melody. Originally from Annecy and now based in Paris, DJ Physical delivers one of the most innovative sounds on the French scene. This partnership promises to immerse us in a stylistic blend of breakbeats, ghetto tech, and rap vocals set to groovy techno.

SOYOON b2b CALLBACKSAMI

Paris/Lyon, France

Soyoon and CallBackSami represent two complementary visions of the electronic scene. Soyoon blends bright trance, dark EBM, and dark disco in captivating sets, driven by the rave energy of the 90s and flawless technique. On the other hand, CallBackSami draws from his 90s vinyl collection to merge prog house, trance, and techno, creating immersive and unifying experiences. Together, they offer an intense and abyssal musical journey, combining minimal, progressive house, and trance for a frenetic and mental dance experience.

LUKE VIBERT

Hypercolour, Planet Mu, Warp | United Kingdom

His appearances in France are rare, highlighting the exceptional nature of his career! A key figure in electronic music, Luke Vibert is known for his eclecticism and bold exploration of multiple genres under his various aliases, with over forty releases in his discography. He has left his mark across a variety of styles, from Trip-Hop to Drum & Bass, including Acid House, both as a solo artist and in collaborations with renowned names like Aphex Twin, Nine Inch Nails, and Squarepusher... Still prolific, Vibert remains an enduring source of inspiration for electronic music lovers and artists, solidifying his central place in both the history and future of the genre.

KOREA TOWN ACID LIVE

Urbnet | Toronto, Canada

Korea Town Acid is an experimental producer, performer, DJ, and curator originally from Seoul and based in Toronto. Known for her genre-defying musical approach, she skillfully blends electronic music, experimental hip-hop, and cinematic soundscapes, creating a unique style that pushes boundaries and captivates her audience. With a prolific catalog of five albums, she remains a visionary artist at the forefront of experimental music, reflecting an unwavering vision and a desire to expand the boundaries of underground music.



FASME LIVE

Central Processing Unit, Feel My Bicep | Nantes, France

Nurtured on Drexciya, James Holden, and Aphex Twin, FASME has developed a strong penchant for using the Roland TB-303 and its signature melodies, quickly establishing himself as one of the rising stars of Acid in France, boosted by prestigious releases on labels like CPU, Nocta Numerica, Acid Avengers, and Feel My Bicep. However, it would be limiting to define the producer by this single label. A true experimentalist, his various productions and upcoming releases showcase the full scope of his universe: IDM, Jungle, Dub—nothing seems off-limits.

DJ CHUIMIX

Lyon, France

DJ Chuimix is a bed among records, weapons forged in a "Rave-Cave," and a passion influenced by a famous British band signed to Mute. Founder of the label Criminal Justice Act, he explores free and colorful techno, rooted in the second Summer of Love and the British rave culture. Blending Bass Music, Progressive House, and Hardcore kicks, he shapes his sets with the vibe of a rooftop at dawn or a free party.

SPEEDY J HYBRID LIVE

Electric Deluxe | Rotterdam, Netherlands

Undisputed master of Dutch techno, Speedy J is a cornerstone of the electronic scene. He released his first tracks in the early 1990s on Plus 8, the label of Richie Hawtin and John Acquaviva. A pioneer of techno in Europe, he didn't just witness its rise, but also helped lay its solid foundations. Over the past decade, he has distinguished himself with the creation of his label Electric Deluxe and his powerful techno productions, moving between standalone tracks and hardware improvisations. Known for his visceral performances, Speedy J continues to excel on the world's biggest stages, with an unmissable set in Lyon for Nuits onores 2025!

GOOOOSE LIVE

SVBKVLT | Shangai, China

Goooose, aka Han Han, is an audiovisual artist based in Shanghai. Close to the SVBKVLT label, the one behind his latest album Rudiments and Trans Aeon Express, a collaborative album with 33EMYBW, Han Han has performed at various prestigious venues on the international scene. His music is driven by the experimentation of different sound techniques, creating a minimalist spectrum filled with groovy, stuttering percussion, powerful basslines, and electrifying breaks—a true infusion of his Drill and Bass influences.

IVM TRIO [MIKA OKI, APULATI BIEN & SÉBASTIEN FORRESTER] LIVE

France / Belgium

As a power trio, Sébastien Forrester, Mika Oki, and Apulati Bien explore instability and unpredictability, surprising both their audience and themselves. United by their passion for free improvisation and the evolution of club music, Inner Voice Movement pushes the boundaries of live electronic music, infusing it with an organic spirit. Mika Oki's sculptural sound design merges with Sébastien Forrester's expressive and ritualistic drumming, and the versatile production of Apulati Bien. Their performances oscillate between brutal shocks, hypnotic rhythms, and dreamy flights.

TAKKAK TAKKAK LIVE

Nyege Nyege Tapes | Berlin, Germany & Vilnius, Lituania

Takkak Takkak is a bold collaboration between Shigeru Ishihara (aka Scotch Rolex) and Mo'ong Santoso Pribadi, blending deafening club rhythms, traditional Asian sounds, and screeching vocals. This transcultural project mixes precarious polyrhythms, DIY drones, and experimental instruments made from recycled objects. Together, they subvert both contemporary and traditional music to create an unconventional, energetic, and ritualistic sonic universe. Their music, influenced by Gqom, Drill, Techno, and Gamelan, stands out for its originality and freshness.



CABEZADENEGO, MBÉ & LEYBLACK PRESENT MIMOSA LIVE

Brazil

MIMOSA is not just a musical project: it's an anthropological approach and a musical archaeology that preserves and celebrates the sounds, movements, rhythms, and languages of Black Brazilian bodies. This project, bringing together Mbé, Leyblack Beats, and Luiz Felipe Lucas, was born from an artist residency in Spain, where the artists explored the Afro-Brazilian creative origins. The result of this immersion is a manifesto album, traversing the powerful rhythms of Terreiro, Samba, Hip-Hop, Drum & Bass, and the many facets of Brazilian Funk.

NADAH EL SHAZLY LIVE

Asadun Alay Records | Cairo, Egypt

Nadah El Shazly started as a musician in a punk band covering the Misfits before turning to electronic music production. Quickly establishing herself on the underground scene in Cairo, she released her debut album Ahwar, which was highly praised by critics, blending buzug, synthesizers, electronics, and vocalselements that have contributed to the growing success of her solo performances. A resident at the Elektronmusikstudion in Stockholm, she has participated in prestigious international festivals such as Norbergfestival, Clandestino Festival, Supersonic, and Le Guess Who?. At Nuits Sonores 2025, Nadah El Shazly will present her new album, set to be released in May 2025 on Björk's label, One Little Independent Records.

ELLEN ALLIEN b2b BADSISTA

BPitch, Bandida | Berlin, Germany & São Paulo, Brazil

A prestigious meeting between Ellen Allien, an iconic figure of global techno, and BADSISTA, a cornerstone of the Brazilian underground scene. A visionary looking to the future, Ellen Allien embodies the very essence of techno: an artist who has shaped her own universe while leaving an indelible mark on electronic culture with her unique sonic DNA. On the other hand, BADSISTA, a producer, DJ, and co-founder of the feminist collective Bandida. stands out for her eclecticism and taste for unclassifiable tracks. With sets where techno, ghetto house, and baile funk intertwine, she builds bridges between genres and asserts herself as a key player on the international stage. Made up of producer Bab, a member of the Musique de Fëte collective, and singer Celinatique, former member of the group Abaya Road, the duo released their debut EP Boussa on the Nowadays label. This EP reflects their commitment to cultural and musical diversity, mixing the sounds of Beirut, Paris, Chicago, and Oran. Constantly exploring this musical alchemy, Tales & Ahlam continue to celebrate sharing, love, and dance.



For the 2025 edition, Nuits Sonores is revamping the format of its nocturnal programme, which will take place at an enhanced version of La Sucrière. The new formula has been shaped by the desire to preserve the club experience so dear to festival-goers while returning to a single night venue equipped with three stages: a main stage and dancefloor, an intimate club and an immersive live space. Dedicated to thriving artistic communities, these stages will showcase a full overview of the international and local music scenes.

NUITS · EDITO

Get lost, be surprised, dare: such is the promise that Nuits Sonores has held for its audiences over the course of the last 22 editions. A sensory journey through the night, a collective adventure in search of the dawn.

In 2025, the festival's Nuits programme will return to a single venue - La Sucrière - and its three aesthetically distinct stages, inviting festival-goers to make new artistic discoveries by strolling and wandering around this ephemeral venue so familiar to many of them. It is a nocturnal journey that will be guided by a lineup showcasing diversity and singularity, in which DJ sets and live performances sit side-byside, featuring artists such as Tshegue, a quintet combining post-funk and epileptic percussion led by vocalist Faby Sy, originally from Kinshasa, and the hallucinogenic live show by the Franco-Japanese group Violent Magic Orchestra, the authors of a unique style of gabber-infused black metal for a post-digital world.

"Dance is the poetry of the foot, and night is its most beautiful setting." In the spirit of these words, uttered by Jean-Georges Noverre, an 18th-century dancer widely considered to be the inventor of modern ballet, the Nuits programme in 2025 aims to serve as a sonic backdrop to the choreographic arts, those tireless acolytes of all genres of rhythm.

Highlights include the premiere of Bodycontrol by the Techno Body Music collective, a set combining industrial music and BDSM performance. Meanwhile, the Lyon Waacking Project collective will be holding dance battles in the purest traditions of 70s disco, to the sound of DJ sets delivered by La Vanda and Najeet.


The Nuits programme is also about light, as harnessed in the unique visual installations that have helped forge the festival's reputation over the years, and which will once again be a key element of La Sucrière's post-dusk offering. Luminescent scenography will also play an active part in the artists' performances, as in the case of A Mirror in Reverse, a hallucinogenic live audiovisual collaboration between musicians James K and Heith and researcher Gunseli, the world premiere of which will be performed as part of the TIMES European cooperation project.

The sublime, timeless setting of La Sucrière will become a playground for a full spectrum of artistic direction, with subtly woven narratives and suggested artistic and historical counterpoints, all placed at the service of a comprehensive, unifying party, fully open to communion and encounters.

Intergenerational encounters, such as those between Lyon's new hard techno scene, embodied by Basswell and Omaks, and French hardcore pioneer Manu Le Malin; encounters between legendary figures, such as Parrish Smith and Mark Knekelhuis, who will be presenting their live techno-punk set Volition Immanent; and unprecedented aesthetic encounters, including one between young French phenomenon Jersey and Interplanetary Criminal, who are working on either side of the Channel to lay the foundations for a house music revival built around faster, more broken rhythms, openly influenced by bass music and unashamedly flirting with pop aesthetics.

Last but not least, these nights will also be the opportunity to meet up, to join together and to celebrate the unbreakable friendships that have formed between some of the festival's most iconic artists: Busy P and Mad Rey, Jennifer Cardini and Pablo Bozzi, and Chloé and Solomun.

In these times of loneliness, disorientation and social fragmentation, Nuits Sonores offers moments of communion and reunion, a collective journey through the night that is more necessary than ever.



NUIT 1 CENTRAL

Dischi Autunno & Correspondant I France & Allemagne

A summit meeting with this highly anticipated B2B between two Nuits Sonores veterans. On one side, Jennifer Cardini, an essential figure of the French scene, who has been part of the electronic music history since her early days at Pulp in the 90s. Creator of the labels Dischi Autunno, Correspondant, and more recently Faeries, and a music activist for over three decades, she curated a Day at the 2018 edition of the festival and closed the Nef stage on Day 3 last year in a musical maelstrom only she can create.

On the other side, Pablo Bozzi, who in just a few years has made a name for himself with numerous productions and collaborations, bringing a revival of dark disco, infusing his DJ sets with a unique style influenced by trance, EBM, eurodance, and 90s sounds. Alongside his partner Kendal, the Toulouse native now based in Berlin had taken over the Soundsystem stage in 2024 during a memorable Closing Day. This clash of titans, previously presented multiple times at Le Sucre, promises an all-terrain set with unparalleled energy during the first night of this edition.

From a residency at Amsterdam's Spielraum to her appearances at techno temples the world over, KI/KI stands confidently at the forefront of a new rave resurrection. With her virtuoso blend of acid, techno and trance, she takes her audiences on a journey beyond time and into a fast-paced, dreamlike sonic realm. After Leave It To The Vibe and 5 Mins Of Acid, her first two EPs, KI/KI is back on her own label, Slash, in 2025 with Getting Ready For The Party, her new EP in collaboration with Storm Mollison.

FUNK TRIBU

Colombie, Allemagne

Funk Tribu is a producer and dj from Colombia, based in Berlin. His music is highly influenced by the electronic sound of the 90s & '00s, creating a retro-futuristic atmosphere. Since his mega hit Phonky Tribu, Funk Tribu is known for shaping the groovy trance sound nowadays with his genre-fluid productions.

Safe Ground Recordings | Brussels, Belgium

LB Marszałek is a composer and producer known for his deep, immersive sound explorations, A resident at Kiosk Radio in Brussels and Stegi Radio in Athens, he curates shows alongside artists like Kaitlyn Aurelia Smith and Crystallmess. Through his label Safe Ground Recordings, he bridges music and social engagement, supporting essential causes like Sea-Watch and Choose Love. His latest project, Homeostatic Loops, offers an ambient and poetic journey where synthesizers blend with everyday sounds to create spaces of calm and beauty. Currently, he is collaborating on the soundtrack for the film Real Faces, directed by Leni Huyghe, alongside Natasha Pirard. The film is set to premiere at the SXSW festival in 2025.

naff recordings | Montreal, Canada

Steeped in science fiction and fantasy, Priori crafts a sonic universe where ambient, dub techno, acid, and IDM merge into an organic and futuristic alchemy. His compositions weave shifting textures, balancing between nature and machine, the tangible and the imagined. Co-founder of the Montreal-based label NAFF Recordings and one half of Jump Source, his house duo with Patrick Holland, Priori is a driving force in the underground scene, shaping the present and anticipating the future. Highly prolific, 2024 sees him releasing Learn to Fly, one of his many EPs, C.R.U.S.H., his collaborative EP with Bambounou, and This but More, his fourth album. Quite the lineup!

VITESS LIVE

Retro Futura | Paris, France

Vitess is part of a new wave of Parisian producers to keep a close eye on. A trained drummer, he quickly built a strong reputation with his electrifying live sets, where warm grooves blend seamlessly with house and power house rhythms. After standout releases on Houseum Records, YoY, Hoarder, and Terrafirm, he took things to the next level in 2022 by launching his own label, Retro Futura. Shortly after, he unveiled his debut album, Cyber Zone. His ever-evolving live performances, designed for the dancefloor, have already taken him around the world.

JOHANNES BRECHT LIVE

Germany

Johannes Brecht is a German composer and producer who blends classical music and electronic sounds with subtlety. Trained in jazz and double bass, he has made a name for himself on labels like Diynamic Music, collaborating with Stimming and Henrik Schwarz. His track "Voix Grave" topped the Deep House chart on Beatport, and "Page Blanche" was featured in GTA V. A regular at Berlin clubs and major festivals like Tomorrowland, he creates a hybrid sound that merges techno with orchestral influences. 

Between 2013 and 2020, he released several EPs on D.KO Records, including the famous Quartier Sex. In 2021, he collaborated with rapper Jwles on the track Joe Da Zin, the first single from his EP B.R.O on Ed Banger, and is set to release his debut album please don't wait in early 2025.

IWI FS LIVE

LTR Worldwide | Paris, France

For the past ten years, Jwles has been shaping his world between New York, Grasse, and Saint-Denis. He founded the LTR collective, experimenting with French and English flows while drawing influences from '90s rap, jazz, electro, and reggae.

In recent years, he has surrounded himself with Mad Rey and Blasé, with whom he shares a passion for house, jazz, and rap. Their studio chemistry is undeniable—Mad Rey produced much of Le Zin & les autres, alongside Kostral One and Thxnk.

Closely linked to the new wave of French rap, particularly through his DMV-style flow, Jwles showcases his creative freedom in his latest album, Bijoux. The project features short, punchy tracks that balance storytelling with raw energy, each song adding a new shade to his sonic universe.



GIRL ULTRA DJSET

Big Bada | Mexico

Based in Mexico City, Girl Ultra is regarded as one of the most innovative artists in her country, thanks to her ability to blend R&B, indie rock, electronic, and Latin music. Her performances on Tiny Desk, KEXP, Colors Berlin, Boiler Room, and at festivals like Primavera and Coachella have cemented her reputation as a performer and highlighted her ability to break free from any stylistic or genre constraints.

CASHU & RHR

Mamba Negra | São Paulo, Brazil

Cashu, aka Carolina Schutzer, and RHR are two key figures in the Brazilian electronic music scene. 



This original creation commissioned by TIMES is co-produced by Nuits Sonores, Terraforma, Reworks, and Sónar.



TECHNO-POLITICS

The year 2025 opened with an image: Elon Musk. the head of one of the world's biggest social media platforms, as well as Tesla and SpaceX. making two Nazi salutes at the inauguration of the new President of the United States of America. It was a gesture that crystallises the alliance between reactionary nationalism and techno-capitalism, one further reinforced by the funding given to Donald Trump by Meta and Spotify. But what consequences will the concentration of power in the hands of the broligarchy have for the rest of the world? How can we fight back against the spread of racist and sexist ideologies that impose the law of the strongest on a global scale? And, how can the independent culture sector continue to exist and equip itself to contend with these platforms, upon which it still relies for visibility? The rise of MAGMA (Meta, Apple, Google, Microsoft, Amazon) is symptomatic of the profound recalibration of the global economy in favour of Big Tech. According to economists Cédric Durand and Yánis Varoufákis, we are now witnessing the advent of techno-feudalism, in which digital giants are progressively supplanting the traditional mechanisms of capitalism. Their domination is built around cloud capital; the platforms are fuelled by the income generated from the free contributions of internet users.

With 90% of online searches controlled by Google, and YouTube and Instagram reaching more than 2.5 billion users in 2023, the concentration of global data in the possession of a handful of companies poses an immense threat to democracy. Enjoying a virtual monopoly on new information and communication technologies, the MAGMA giants are exerting a worrying influence over the public debate via their complex algorithms.

This hyper-control over information has also given rise to techno-political meddling in conflicts, which could have dramatic consequences in times of geopolitical crisis. In December 2023, a Human Rights Watch report accused Meta of systematically censoring Palestinian voices around the world on Instagram

and Facebook, thereby obstructing the dissemination of information on Israeli war crimes and limiting the mobilisation of international support.

Furthermore, since 7 October 2023, investigations by the independent media outlets +972 and Local Call have revealed the Israeli army's considerable reliance on technologies developed by Google, Microsoft and Amazon – which, according to one of its spokespersons, provide it with greater "operational effectiveness" in carrying out its ethnic cleansing in Gaza.

In Europe, the European Commission has opened an investigation into TikTok following suspicions of Russian interference in the Romanian presidential elections. The Romanian authorities have accused the Chinese application of facilitating the manipulation of the 2024 elections in favour of Calin Georgescu, the pro-Russian far-right candidate who surprised everyone by winning the first round on 24 November, Despite Meta and TikTok having taken measures to ban Russian state media in order to combat foreign interference since the start of the full-scale invasion of Ukraine, the platforms remain powerful tools for Russian propaganda, On the internet, various European countries have fallen victim to disinformation attacks, such as those carried out by the APT28 hacker group or the Russian network Portal Kombat, aimed at weakening Western support for Ukraine.

In 2025, it has become more essential than ever to deconstruct the fictions shaped by engineers of chaos, and to decolonise the narratives of the past in order to strengthen our understanding of the present and build for the future. In addition to international tension, economic crises and geopolitical conflicts, structural challenges are having an impact on our cultures, our democracies and our collective imagination. In the face of this urgent situation, Nuits Sonores Lab is opening up a space for debate, reflection and resourcefulness at the heart of the festival, so that we can collectively claim the upper hand on this new techno-political frontline.

WORKSHOPS

Each day, free and accessible workshops and training sessions will be offered to go further on the festival's key themes and go from theory to practice. A chance for everyone to empower themselves with tools to better understand and take action in today's world.

All workshops are free upon registration

TALKS

Designed as spaces for reflection, these talks will foster debate and dialogue at the heart of the festival. They connect artists, activists, thinkers, and European journalists, inviting them to explore the pressing challenges facing our contemporary societies.

A CONVERSATION WITH

A journalist will host discussions with musicians and artists from the festival's line-up to explore their artistic practices and perspectives on the future of music.

The MAGMAs (Meta, Apple, Google, Microsoft and Amazon) wield unprecedented technological and financial power, shaping our behaviour and capturing massive amounts of personal data. With 90% of online searches conducted via Google and over 2.5 billion users of YouTube and Instagram by 2023, a handful of companies control access to information and shape public debate through opaque algorithms. This extreme concentration of technology and data threatens our digital freedoms, increases our dependence on private platforms and poses a major risk to our democracies by influencing public debate. Exploitation of data, opaque algorithms, lack of effective regulation: how can we regain control of our digital uses? How can we ensure that people remain the masters of technology, and not the other way round? This workshop will formulate concrete solutions to free ourselves from these web giants. Angie Gaudion, a member of the Framasoft nonprofit, will present free and ethical alternatives to take back control of our digital tools.

TALK — TECH AS A NEW COLONIAL FORCE

What is techno-colonialism and how can we bring about the struggles for independence that we need? If big tech companies have become empires, it's because we have been colonised by their technical deployments. In the face of extractive logics—from the extraction of metals and rare earths in the global South to the racist biases of artificial intelligence—digital technology is revealing itself to be a new terrain of colonialism, embodied today in the colonialism of data. This social order, in which the continuous extraction of data generates massive wealth and global inequalities, imposes a social contract in which progress requires us to hand over our information to companies unconditionally. The digitisation of our lives profoundly redefines power relations, reminding us that capitalism, intrinsically linked to colonialism, exploits our lives, as Achille Mbembe pointed out: 'We are the ore that our objects are responsible for extracting'. TALK — HOW CAN TECHNO-FEUDALISM BE COUNTERED AT A TIME OF RISING FASCISM?

"Capitalism is dead. Now we have something much worse". For Yanis Varoufakis, Greek economist, capitalism has mutated into a technologically advanced form of feudalism. The ruling class is no longer based on ownership of the means of production, but on cloud capital: sprawling platforms where a few billionaires extract exorbitant rents from the data and engagement of Internet users, while shaping public debate. This project is not just economic, it is also political. 2025 opens with a shocking image: Elon Musk giving two Nazi salutes at the inauguration of the President of the United States. A symbol of the rise of global fascism, financed and amplified by tech. Meta and Spotify are investing in Trump, algorithms are promoting radicalisation, and disinformation is spreading unhindered. From Trump to Putin, from Modi to Milei, a fascist international is growing stronger, advocating identitarianism, the rejection of minorities and the dismantling of institutions. In France, the Rassemblement National is exploiting the flaws in the platforms to extend its influence. How can we counter this alliance between big tech and far-right ideas? What is exactly the role of AI in this alliance? What can we do to regain control of our digital spaces and protect democracy? This talk will analyse the mechanisms of contemporary fascism and explore strategies of resistance to this new era of techno-feudalism.

In these dark political times, democracy is being reinvented—not in parliaments or institutions, but in the darkness of the club. As the bassline pulses and bodies move in unison—or in chaotic defiance—European club culture reveals itself as more than just a space for escape. These nocturnal worlds function as alternative political microcosms where, for a fleeting moment, new forms of governance emerge: self-regulation replaces surveillance, trust outweighs control, and collective euphoria dissolves social divisions—if only for a night.

Philosophers like Nina Power and Hakim Bey describe clubs as Temporary Autonomous Zones, ephemeral spaces where alternative social structures take shape, challenging dominant power dynamics. Within these zones, authority is fluid, unwritten codes dictate behavior, and solidarity becomes a form of resistance.

As authoritarianism rises and democracies are increasingly threatened by algorithmic control, disinformation, and polarization, we turn to the club as a utopian experiment, exploring its role as a breeding ground for resilient democratic practices.

Could the principles of club culture—fluid hierarchies, radical inclusivity, self-organization—offer a blueprint for strengthening democracy in an era of digital surveillance and corporate control? How do these nocturnal spaces navigate the tension between freedom and regulation? And what can they teach us about resisting systems of power?

This interactive session will examine what underground nightlife reveals about governance, autonomy, and collective responsibility. Participants will map the politics of the club, exploring how its ethos of self-governance and communal trust can inspire new democratic strategies. Can these fleeting, self-sustaining communities of the night inspire real-world political engagement by day?

TALK — ARE WE DISCUSSING MORE ELECTRONIC MUSIC THAN EXPERIENCING IT IN 2025?

Ten years ago, festivals featuring talks and panel discussions were a minority in the event landscape. Today, they are numerous—perhaps even dominant. The media ecosystem surrounding this culture has also expanded significantly. Podcasts, newsletters, Instagram and TikTok pages: the platforms for dissecting the dynamics of the "electronic scene" have multiplied, offering new opportunities for many observers, journalists, and enthusiasts to contribute to the conversation. This shift has been accompanied by a growing body of literature on the subject, with an increasing number of essays, theses, and even novels exploring these topics.

At the same time, are we witnessing a decline in club practices? And a growing disinterest among younger generations in nightlife? Some weak signals, reports, and observations—such as those highlighted by journalist Chal Ravens—seem to suggest so. This has led her to write in The Quietus that we are witnessing a form of "Academisation of Rave."

As part of the Nuits sonores Lab debate forum, she will discuss this ambivalence alongside Elijah, a keen observer of music industry trends who deciphers them through his Yellow Square project, as well as Günseli Yalcinkaya, author and researcher.

KEYNOTE — BREAKING THE CIRCLE: RAISING AWARENESS ON THE CONTINUUM OF GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE IN THE NIGHTLIFE ECOSYSTEM

Launched in October 2023, the initiative Reinventing the Night (Réinventer la nuit) brings together artists and activist organizations (Consentis & Au-delà du club) to create a support network and tools dedicated to combating gender-based and discriminatory violence in the nightlife & music industry. To break the isolation caused by such violence, monthly talking circles for gender-minoritized (cis women, trans, and non-binary people) DJs and professionals of the music industry have been held at Point Éphémère (Paris) for over a year. These circles are designed as a political tool for care and empowerment, breaking the vicious cycle of silence and isolation. Within Réinventer la nuit, the collective Au-delà du club conducted an exploratory study to shed light on the intimate and anonymized testimonies shared during these circles. The results will be unveiled for the first time on Thursday 29 May, at Nuits sonores Lab.

TALK — TECHNO-SURVEILLANCE: TECH AT THE SERVICE OF SOCIAL CONTROL

At the end of the 18th century, the utilitarian philosopher Jeremy Bentham theorised the panopticon: a prison architecture enabling a guard, housed in a central tower, to observe all the prisoners, locked up in individual cells around the tower, without them being able to know whether they were being observed. Michel Foucault, in Surveiller et punir, took up this theory and extended it to society as a whole, made possible by social control: the individual, constantly under surveillance, becomes docile, anticipating his actions for fear of being observed. Today, under the guise of security and efficiency, techno-surveillance is insidiously redefining our public spaces. Predictive algorithms, facial recognition, automated video surveillance: these technologies are transforming the city into a laboratory for social control. Yet their effectiveness is widely disputed, and their cost and impact on civil liberties are a cause for concern. In particular, the privatisation of security is fuelling a surveillance capitalism that is undermining citizens' rights. This discussion will explore the political and ethical issues surrounding technopolitics in the age of artificial intelligence: who is monitoring and for what purpose? What dangers do these devices pose when they divert our attention from systemic violence? With Synth Media, we will explore the place of these tools in our societies and the possible resistance to their widespread use.

WORKSHOP — AI AND OPEN SOURCE IN SOUND CREATION: BREAKING FREE FROM BIG TECH

In this workshop, Matheus Sousa de Freitas, Lucien Basdevant and Félix Lacquement will propose innovative approaches combining art, technology and political and social reflection. From the integration of Al and machine learning tools into hardware set-ups, to the adoption of Csound as a lever for emancipation, in resonance with the concept of techno-feudalism, or the use of Al in computer programming to enrich self-education, this workshop will explore, in a plural and committed vision, how art, technology and social reflection intertwine to open up new avenues of emancipation.

WORKSHOP — THE INTERNET IS A HORRIBLE PLACE AND I'M HERE TO MAKE IT WORSE

The workshop is inspired by The Kawayoku Inception, the research project by Noura Tafeche that delves into the political-artistic value of cuteness and the permanent status of performativity and hypersexualisation on social media as agents of a growing trend towards the aestheticisation of violence.

The project investigates contemporary digital evanescence, the visual reformulation of violence, unconventional recruitment strategies and militarised entertainment under new taxonomies in research areas ranging from 'Israeli' and US military propaganda and recruitment strategies translated into choreographies and dance challenges, to the weeb alt-right imagery intertwined with the fan-art of cute manga, passing through video games and the Second Amendment, gun advocates, war enthusiasts or armies employing anime and kawaii aesthetics and rape culture.

From this research, conducted over four years on popular social media and remote online micro-communities, an archive has been built that catalogues almost 30,000 files (screenshots, memes, posts, videos, etc.) with a 'geographical map' of the digital platforms where the phenomenon proliferates.

During the workshop, the artist will guide participants through an intricate network of niche telegram channels, discord servers, popular subreddits, official and fake user accounts and bases, providing them with a strategic toolbox for investigating and analysing fringe Internet communities that are involved, in different ways and degrees, in the production and reproduction of online violence.

RADIO — RADIO LAB WITH MUTANT RADIO

Donald Trump insults Zelensky, branding him a "dictator" and blaming Ukraine for the war with Russia. Meanwhile, Elon Musk supports the AfD and allows fake news to spread unchecked on X, amplifying reactionary content. American technocracy is no longer merely shaping public debate, it is destabilising European democracies.

Ukraine and Georgia are on the front lines of a battle fought not only militarily and politically, but also in the information sphere. In Georgia, where traditional media is under constant pressure, protests unfold simultaneously in public squares and on social platform, the last stronghold of independent discourse. But how can resistance persist when the very tools of communication are controlled by corporations that censor, manipulate, and suppress? How do social networks become battlegrounds for self-organisation and mobilisation against authoritarian regimes?

On the cultural front, Ukrainian and Georgian artists create under the constant shadow of war, repression, and instability. Their DIY scenes are not peripheral; they are at the heart of Europe's cultural resistance. But for these voices to have real impact, transnational solidarities must be built. How can Ukrainian and Georgian artists be better represented? How can their struggles inform broader European movements for artistic independence and cultural self-determination? In a time of growing digital monopolies, rising far-right influence, and shrinking creative freedoms, how do we rethink resistance, reimagine community, and carve out new spaces for artistic and political autonomy? Leading Tbilisi-based webradio Mutant Radio will stepping out of its famous carriage to broadcast 4 hours of programming from Lyon. A takeover punctuated by discussions, listening sessions and DJ sets focusing on Georgian culture.

RADIO — RADIO LAB WITH RADIO ALHARA

Les Grandes Locos - Radio

What is the role of sound in archiving disappearing spaces? WonderCabinet, the creative hub hosting Radio Alhara on the hills of Palestine, sought to answer this question through its annual residency, Sound of Spaces. The residency's first edition focused on capturing the sonic essence of the Cremisan Valley, the last green space surrounding Bethlehem, soon to be annexed by Israel as part of its ongoing settler-colonial project. In response, sonic artists, artisans, designers, visual artists, and the nuns at the Cremisan monastery, to create a repository of sounds that potentially speaks to the spirits of other environments, landscapes, both close by and on the other side of the world.

Behind this initiative stands the same visionary team behind Radio Alhara, the iconic Bethlehem-based webradio, which will take over the radio booth of Nuits Sonores Lab for an exceptional six-hour broadcast. Navigating similar themes, Yousef Anastas and Saeed Abu Jaber will weave together discussions, listening sessions, and DJ sets to explore the importance of cultural production as a fundamental part of Palestinian resistance to settler-colonialism. It will highlight initiatives that transform sound into a living archive of place and identity, using sonic narratives to reflect on displacement, memory, and resilience. Through this takeover, Radio Alhara will reaffirm its commitment to collective listening and exchange, carving out a space for sonic exploration, storytelling, and artistic defiance.

Located in a former boiler factory in the south of Confluence in Lyon, HEAT is a semi-open space combining dining and lifestyle programming. Somewhere between a food court and a community hub, HEAT will host several open-air events throughout the festival.



FOR A SAFER FESTIVAL

Nuits sonores is committed to making the festival as safe as possible for everyone. For several years, our teams have been working with associations and collectives to implement a series of measures aimed at raising awareness among festival staff and festival-goers about preventing and combatting gender-based and sexual violence:

- → The creation of spaces for prevention, listening, dialogue and exchange open to everyone on the main festival sites;
- → The presence of a team of mediators authorized to take testimony and support the care of victims of violence on the main festival sites;
- → The organisation of shared return journeys for festival-goers, thanks to meeting points on the different sites and/or the help of dedicated volunteers:
- → The presence of first aiders and emergency doctors trained in providing care to victims of gender-based and sexual violence on the main festival sites:
- → The implementation of an awareness campaign promoting a culture of consent on the main festival sites, in collaboration with Consentis;
- → The provision of different types of relevant resources at the festival's information points:
- → Pre-festival training and awareness-raising among volunteers and bar staff on the sites about understanding sexual violence in a festival environment, as well as means of prevention and the culture of consent.

In 2024, Nuits sonores wishes not only to maintain its existing measures but to strengthen its system for preventing and combating gender-based and sexual violence. Our priority is to enable all the teams involved in the festival to be aware and capable of acting proactively on these issues for the good of all the people involved in our events; from volunteers to temporary staff, not to mention the general public.





Since 2022, the festival has had a prevention, listening, dialogue and exchange space open to everyone on the Days site in order to take preventive measures, run awareness workshops and interact freely with festival-goers in a safe and caring setting: the Social Corner. This space is designed to:

- create a safe and caring space on the daytime site of the festival
- raise awareness among festival-goers about the fight against gender-based and sexual violence at festivals, in collaboration with various
- associations
- welcome to the festival members of specialist associations who are trained to hear the testimony of festival-goers, if necessary.



NUITS SONORES, SUSTAINABILITY & SOLIDARITY

Nuits sonores durables et solidaires (NSDS) is a programme first launched in 2010 by the Arty Farty association, the organisers of Nuits sonores. Its aim is to put in place tangible measures to demonstrate the festival's commitment to contemporary economic, social and environmental issues and to contribute to the wider efforts of actors in the cultural and creative industries.

Today, these responsibilities can be broken down into major themes such as accessibility, the environment, inclusion and solidarity, and prevention.

The festival's teams are therefore taking action in relation to a number of different areas, including the accessibility of the festival to people with disabilities, waste management, mobility, responsible communications, re-use and responsible purchasing, restoration, the fight against gender-based and sexist violence, risk reduction, prevention of hearing damage and noise pollution, and the development of lineups that are representative of both local and international scenes and attentive to contemporary issues.

Thanks to the progress made in this regard, Arty Farty and its ecosystem received certification for the international standard for sustainable event management (ISO 20121) in 2023.






